Children in care received many beautiful quilts made by our members at a

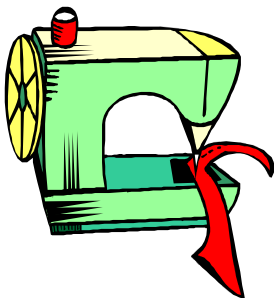
presentation tea last week. This year we will be working hard to make quilts from the huge array of quilting fabrics donated to community quilts. There are several kits made up, and there are lots of choices.

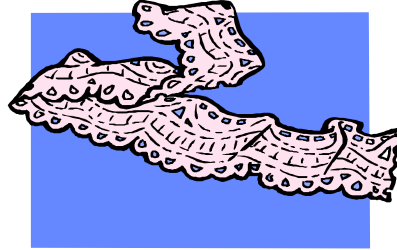
Fabric Exchange Group

This is a great way to get a variety of fabrics for your quilts to add that special sparkle or charm.

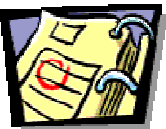
We have upcoming exchanges with stripes, batiks, different color groups and so on.
